

# St Peter Port Walking Tour

Explore historic St Peter Port: the Channel Islands' most beautiful town.

Follow your guide to explore the narrow cobbled streets and learn how the old town has flourished on 2,000 years of seafaring. Visit the Old Quarter and follow your guide along the re-knowned St Peter Port trails to learn more of the towns facinating history.

## Option one

Stop for mid morning/afternoon refreshment at one of St Peter Port's Hotels.

Climb Cornet Street to Hauteville House, the intriguing home of French literary giant Victor Hugo. An industrious writer but perhaps an even more prolific DIY enthusiast, Hugo transformed his home into a rich, romantic and eclectic treasure trove. Be prepared for a fascinating insight into the mind of one of literature's true genius.

## Option two

Have refreshments at St James Concert Hall, the home of the beautiful Millennium tapestry (depicting 800 years of Island history)

## Option three

Organise refreshments and a visit to Candie Museum and gardens for an opportunity to view the beautifully depicted story of Guernsey and the development of its people.
